Need a little help feeding your kids when school is out for summer?

Learn how the new SUN Bucks program can help you!

SUN Bucks is a new program to help families buy food for their schoolaged children during the summer. Families will get \$120 for each eligible child to buy groceries during the summer. Children who get **SUN Bucks** can still participate in other summer meal programs. Receiving **SUN Bucks** will not affect children or families' immigration status.



Your child is eligible for **SUN Bucks** if:


They are a member in a household that receives **benefits from SNAP/Basic Food, FDPIR, TANF**

OR

They attend a school that offers the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Program, **and** qualify for benefits based on household income through a meal application or Family Income Survey

How does SUN Bucks work?

In Washington, SUN Bucks will be loaded onto an EBT card and mailed to your home. If eligible, you can use SUN Bucks benefits to buy food like fruits, vegetables, meat, whole grains, and dairy at grocery stores, farmers markets, and other places that accept Basic Food EBT benefits.



Update your address by contacting your child's school to ensure your SUN Bucks benefits are sent to the correct address! After June 14, call SunBucks call center.





How do I enroll my child in SUN Bucks?

Many families will get **SUN Bucks** automatically if they are getting other benefits, but some families may need to apply for the program.

Basic Food, FDPIR, TANF, your child will be automatically enrolled in the

SUN Bucks program. You do not need to fill out an application. You will get a card in the mail. Watch for the Sun Bucks card in the mail in July or August.

If you have filled out a meal application or a family income survey this school year and were eligible for free/reduced meals or waived fees you will be enrolled automatically in the SUN Bucks program.
