

Need a little help feeding your kids when school is out for summer?

Learn how the new **SUN Bucks** program can help you!

SUN Bucks is a new program to help families buy food for their school-aged children during the summer. Families will get \$120 for each eligible child to buy groceries during the summer. Children who get **SUN Bucks** can still participate in other summer meal programs. Receiving **SUN Bucks** will not affect children or families' immigration status.

Is my child eligible for **SUN Bucks**?

Your child is eligible for **SUN Bucks** if:

They are a member in a household that receives **benefits from SNAP/Basic Food, FDPIR, TANF**

OR

They attend a school that offers the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Program, **and** qualify for benefits based on household income through a meal application or Family Income Survey

How does **SUN Bucks** work?

In **Washington**, **SUN Bucks** will be **loaded onto an EBT card and mailed to your home**. If eligible, you can use **SUN Bucks** benefits to buy food like fruits, vegetables, meat, whole grains, and dairy at grocery stores, farmers markets, and other places that accept **Basic Food EBT** benefits.



Recently moved? Or do one of these programs have an old address for you?

Update your address by **contacting your child's school** to ensure your **SUN Bucks** benefits are sent to the correct address! After June 14, call SunBucks call center.



How do I enroll my child in SUN Bucks?

Many families will get **SUN Bucks** automatically if they are getting other benefits, but some families may need to apply for the program.

If your household already participates in: **Basic Food, FDPIR, TANF**, your child will be automatically enrolled in the **SUN Bucks** program. You do not need to fill out an application. You will **get a card in the mail**. Watch for the **Sun Bucks card in the mail in July or August**.

If you have filled out a meal application or a family income survey this school year and were eligible for free/reduced meals or waived fees you will be enrolled automatically in the SUN Bucks program.
